Dear family, brothers and sisters in Christ,

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

Greetings from Calgary, Canada! Recently Liza got a message from one of the members from the Living Stone Church in Cambodia about her dream. In her dream she saw God came and judged the world by sending rain and flood to destroy the world. Anyone who had a ticket could get into the big boat. The flood came and covered the land and mountains; she saw many people and even Christian friends were in the water. She was holding a girl and tried to get to a safe place! When she woke up, she was very scared and hopeless. Liza shared some verses from Matthew 24 and asked her to read the whole chapter. She wrote back and was relieved because she is one of the chosen ones and that God will not use flood to destroy the world again as is recorded in Genesis 9:11. She works in a Christian NGO and comes to church regularly; she is a more mature Christian. For most Cambodians they don't have a habit of reading. Even for Christians they are not familiar with the words of God. We shared this with our Khmer staff during our zoom prayer meeting. Savy expressed her appreciation for reading God's words 5 mornings a week with Joseph before until now. She knows more about God's words and where to find the verses. She is keen to teach God's words to our members. Praying that our staff, church members will thirst after His words.

Praise items:

- There have been more young people coming to our Living Stone Church; one of them is Bopha, a friend of Ponleu. Ponleu is the one who graduated with high honor from high school. He is now admitted to a Christian dormitory which provides free food and lodging. It's a relief to him because he has no family in Phnom Penh. He is one of the pianists for the Sunday worship.
- Savy is keen to teach the church members to study God's words! The reason why she teaches the nannies at our Sonlight Kindergarten is for them to learn the Khmer language so that they can read God's words on their own.
- Ourselves, our children and grandchildren are healthy despite the rising number of covid cases in our city.

Prayer items:

- The Department of Finance in Cambodia has a new policy to computerize all information of business, foreign organizations and even Non-Government Organizations. So far, we haven't had any information on how to do it. Angel Gao needs wisdom and patience to do this for our mission.
- Our Sonlight Kindergarten is still looking for 2 English teachers.
- We have contact with "New Life School" to see the opportunity to send our students to their grade school so that the students can have Christian environments and values after they leave us. This school is very near to us, and many students are from this area.
- Som Neang whom we asked for prayer has moved back to her husband. Please pray for her relationship with her husband and her faith in God will grow, and the salvation of her husband.

- Mei Mei, who received Jesus into her life during Franklin Graham's meeting about 3 years ago, has seen evil spirits at night. She came forth to receive prayers 2 weeks ago after the Sunday service. Pray that she will have total deliverance and grow in her faith.
