We're thankful that we could live with them adjusting to the new life in Calgary. Our daughter is planning to further her studies in Europe, and they will sell their house. So we have to find another place to live and God provides a new home for us! On the 14th of this month we moved into a rented condo in the northwest of the city. Praise the Lord, it was a nice day with sunshine and warm weather; two days later there's a big snowstorm with strong winds blowing which made the temperature drop to - 30 degrees Celsius. God indeed is so good and faithful!

We're grateful for all your support and prayers. Please continue to praise God for His work in our lives and in the Living Stone Church, also pray for our needs too. Thank you.

- For the nice apartment that we are renting. There are two bedrooms, two bathrooms and a shower. Every morning, we enjoy looking at the sunrise that reminds us of God's wonderful creation!
- Our local workers have reconciled their differences in serving in the Living Stone Church. They work together with humility and compassion.
- The outreach program in Takeo province is going on well. The pastoral staff, and some church members serve there once a month.
